

# WANTED Dead or Alive



A Japanese tourist recently took a photo of a skipper on Guam which has never been collected here. The name of this new skipper is *Hylephila philaeus*. The leftmost specimen above is a female and the 2nd from the left is a male. The two specimens on the right are *Taractrocera luzonensis*, a closely related species which is common on Guam. These skippers are small butterflies with a wingspan of about 1 to 1.5 inches. Each AG109 student who brings in a properly pinned *H. philaeus* will be awarded an extra 20% on his/her final grade.
